## **Comorbidity**

Pursuant to section 16(1)(c) of the Parliamentary Committees Act 1991 the Social Development Committee is conducting an inquiry into Co-morbidity, which may refer to a dual diagnosis of, intellectual disability and/or acquired brain injury, with either or all of the following:

- Mental illness;
- Chronic substance abuse.

### Terms of Reference

1. Facilities in South Australia currently treating people with a dual diagnosis including the Margaret Tobin Centre and James Nash House;
2. The level of training offered to general practitioners, psychologists, psychiatrists and other relevant professionals in the area of dual diagnosis and possible measures to enhance that training;
3. Information given to individuals and carers on how to manage a dual diagnosis;
4. Supports to aid individuals and carers in managing and living with a dual diagnosis; and
5. Any other related matter
