The Information Service at the Office of the Public Advocate (OPA) provides information to the community, service providers, and professionals in relevant fields.

The Information Service provides information about:

- Advance Care Directives (ACD)
- Enduring Powers of Attorney (EPA)
- Guardianship Orders
- Administration Orders
- The South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT) and their processes
- Consent to Medical Treatment
- Informal Arrangements

The Information Service does not:

- Function as a reporting body.
- Give legal advice.
